HABITAT FOR HUMANITY HOUSES IN-A-BOX TO BE BUILT IN GLENVIEW

Glenview, IL—Association Management Center (AMC) announced today that it will host the build site for two 2-bedroom houses as part of a Habitat for Humanity Program. The houses will be framed in Glenview and then trucked to Slidell, LA where they will be assembled by a team of volunteers, including several AMC Employees.

In response to Hurricane Katrina's destruction last fall, where it is estimated over 350,000 families lost their homes, Habitat for Humanity launched a nationwide program called Operation Home Delivery (OHD). The goal of the OHD program is to build 100 homes by June 30, 2007. The House In-A-Box Program is part of the OHD initiative.

Jeff Engle, AMC principal and Habitat volunteer, comments, "Last year our team was in Slidell, LA and participated on the receiving end of OHD. We built 3 foundations for OHD homes and then unloaded pre-built wall sections for the first houses that were delivered as part of this program. This year we have committed to building houses and bringing them with us as we return to Slidell in late October. "

The framing of the house will take place in AMC's parking lot, 4700 W. Lake Ave, Glenview, during two Saturdays: October 7 and 14, from 10 am–3 pm. Over 30 volunteers from this year's Habitat trip, as well as corporate sponsors to the House In-A-Box initiative will be among the builders. The event is open to the community.

In addition to acquiring the framing materials locally, funds must be raised for the remaining materials and land for the houses. The total cost for the houses is \$50,000.
